

MORTON COUNTY PARK DEPARTMENT GENERAL PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- No Disorderly conduct. No Loud music
- No careless or reckless driving. Obey all speed limits
- Operation of any motorized vehicle off designated trails or roads is prohibited. No operation of ATV's, dirt bikes, snowmobiles, or other off-road vehicles unless otherwise posted
- No vandalism
- No removal of park structures, fixtures, signs, or vegetation. No cutting of trees
- Littering and depositing of garbage prohibited
- Campfires must be in approved fire containers only
- No pit Bar-B-Que's
- No burning of trash, rubbish, or other hazardous materials. Burning of lumber containing nails, staples, or other metal is prohibited
- Cutting of firewood is prohibited without a permit
- No discharge of fireworks or explosives
- All pets must be on a leash or be properly controlled
 - *Harmon Lake, Graner Park, and Fort Rice all pets must be on a maximum of 10ft leash and be properly controlled.
- All pets are prohibited on beaches and playgrounds
- All pet waste must be bagged and disposed of in an appropriate waste container
- No glass beverage containers
- Camping anywhere within any county owned or managed recreation area in excess of 10 consecutive days is strictly prohibited
- It is prohibited to leave an occupied campsite unattended in excess of 24-hours
- Day use times - 6:00 AM to 11:00 PM (unless in the act of lawful fishing)
- Quiet times - 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM

VIOLATION OF PARK RULES IS AN INFRACTION PUNISHABLE BY A \$500 MAXIMUM FINE. ALL VIOLATIONS OF PARK RULES WILL BE REPORTED TO THE MORTON COUNTY SHERIFF AND MORTON COUNTY STATES ATTORNEY.
