Land Status

- Campground

- No use of motor vehicles, motorized equipment, or other form of mechanical transport is allowed in wilderness.
- No off-route travel is allowed in limited use areas.
- County roads (open to street legal vehicles only) are often graded dirt roads and are considered "easy"; open routes are generally considered "moderately difficult."
- Designated routes in Lark Canyon are "limited" to off-highway vehicles less than 40 inches in width. Routes east of McCain Valley Road are nonmotorized and open for mechanical use (such as bicycles).
- Routes that are designated as "open" are suitable for all types of off-highway vehicles including motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles, and 4x4 vehicles.
