FOREST ORDER

USDA FOREST SERVICE ARAPAHO NATIONAL FOREST SULPHUR RANGER DISTRICT

OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited the National Forest System (NFS) lands on the Sulphur Ranger District of the Arapaho National Forest described below and depicted on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "Restricted Area").

The Restricted Area is the ¼ mile on either side of NFS Road 148 and NFS Road 156 as shown on Exhibit A. The Restricted Area is located in Sections 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, Township 2 South, Range 75 West, 6th P.M.

The purpose of this Order is to protect natural resources and the water quality in the adjacent streams.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Camping. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(e)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

- (1) Persons with a Forest Service special use authorization or other authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.

This Order will remain in effect for one (1) year from the date signed, unless amended or rescinded.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
