ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR RESTRICTING OCCUPANCY and USE TO WIT: CAMPING

FINGER LAKES NATIONAL FOREST NEW YORK

Under the authority of the Act of Congress dated June 4, 1897, as amended (16 U.S.C. 551), and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth at 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)), the following acts and omissions are prohibited on the Finger Lakes National Forest, New York

DEVELOPED RECREATION SITES

- 1. Camping at a campsite for longer than one-half (1/2) hour after arrival at said campsite unless a fee has been paid per posted instructions. (36 CFR 261.58 (a))
- 2. Camping at a campsite after 2:00 p.m. unless payment of a camping fee for said campsite has been paid as per posted instructions. (36 CFR 261.58 (e))
- 3. Occupancy of campsites at Blueberry Patch Campground by more than 8 persons per site. (36 CFR 261.58 (f).
- 4. Possession of more than two (2) motor vehicles per site at the Blueberry Patch Campground (36 CFR 261.58(i)).

FOREST WIDE

- 5. Camping for a period longer than 14 days in any 30 day period (36 CFR 261.58 (a))
- 6. Camping within fifty (50) feet of a pond, stream, or designated trail, **EXCEPT** for area already developed and maintained for camping. (36 CFR 261.58(e))
- 7. Camping on National Forest pasture lands when livestock are present. (36 CFR 261.58(e))
- 8. Camping for more than two (2) continuous nights at any trail shelter. (36 CFR261.58(a))

THESE RESTRICTIONS ARE NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND TO PROTECT NATIONAL FOREST PROPERTY. THEY ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS SET FORTH IN 36 CFR PART 261. THE PROHIBITION WILL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF THIS ORDER UNTIL SPECIFICALLY WITHDRAWN BY TERMINATION ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member or an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty [36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)]; and,
- 2. Persons with a valid permit signed by the District Ranger or Forest Supervisor in their possession that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission [36 CFR 261.50 (e)(1)].

ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR RESTRICTING OCCUPANCY and USE TO WIT: CAMPING

Violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for and organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both, under authority of Title 16 U.S.C. 551, Title 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
