UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOREST SERVICE KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST 14 DAY CAMPING LIMIT IN A CONSECUTIVE 30 DAY PERIOD

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. § 261.58 (a), the following act is prohibited within the boundaries of the Kaibab National Forest, Coconino County, Arizona.

1. Camping for more than 14 days in any 30 day period: 36 C.F.R. § 261.58 (a)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- 2. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

RESTRICTED AREA

The restricted area includes all National Forest System lands within the boundaries of the Kaibab National Forest, as depicted on the attached map and is hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is for the:

- Protection of National Forest visitors and employees, the prevention of user conflicts,
- Conservation of natural resources,
- Protection of property belonging to the United States,
- Implement the Kaibab National Forest Plan Standard for allowable occupancy.

IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. This Order becomes effective on May 7th, 2020 and will remain in effect until May 7th, 2022 or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
- 2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581]A map identifying the Restricted Area is attached and made a part of this Order


