Occupancy and Use**

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a), the following is prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) lands in the Palisades and Teton Basin Ranger Districts, Caribou-Targhee National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibits A-C (the "Described Areas"):

1. Camping within the same five-mile radius for more than 5 days in any fourteen (14) day period from **May 1 to September 1 in Described Areas A and B.** 36 CFR § 261.58(a)
2. Camping within the same five-mile radius for more than 5 days in any fourteen (14) day period **year-round in Described Area C.** 36 CFR § 261.58(a)

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.

**DESCRIBED AREAS**

**Described Area A (shown on Exhibit A): All NFS lands on the Palisades Ranger District as follows:**

- The area from NFSR #058 (Bear Creek Road) to the shoreline of Palisades Reservoir, beginning at the Palisades Dam and ending at the junction with NFSR #48.
- The area 1 mile north of Palisades Dam to include all the area from the US HWY 26 to the South Fork of the Snake River west to NFSR #076.
- The area from US HWY 26 to the shoreline of the Palisades Reservoir, beginning at the

- Palisades Dam and ending at Alpine Campground.
- The area from NFSR #087 (McCoy Creek) to the shoreline of the Palisades Reservoir beginning at the junction of US HWY 89 and #087 and ending at the McCoy Creek Bridge.
- Within a ¼ mile of the entire NFSR #268 (Little Elk Canyon), NFSR #262 (Big Elk Canyon), NFSR #271 (Blowout Canyon), NFSR #281 (Indian Creek), NFSR # 217 (Table Rock Canyon), NFSR #218 (Kelly Canyon), and NFSR #206 (South Fork Snake River).
- All Forest lands from Alpine Campground South to McCoy Creek around Alpine.

**Described Area B (shown on Exhibit B): All NFS lands on the Palisades Ranger District as Follows:**

- Within a ¼ mile of the entire NFSR # 217 (Table Rock Canyon), NFSR #218 (Kelly Canyon), and NFSR #206 (South Fork Snake River).
- Within a ¼ mile of NFSR #077 (Fall Creek-Skyline) from the junction with NFSR# 076 (Snake River-Calamity) to the junction of NFSR #066 (Blacktail Canyon-Point Lookout).

**Described Area C (shown on Exhibit C): All NFS lands on the Teton Basin Ranger District as Follows:**

- Within a ¼ mile of the entire NFSR #239 (Mike Harris Canyon) and NFSR #276 (Moose Creek).
- Within a ¼ mile of US HWY 22 starting at the top of Teton Pass in Wyoming and heading west to the Forest Boundary.

## **PURPOSE**

To manage high recreation use in the Described Areas.

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order shall be in effect from March 30, 2023 at 1200 through March 30, 2028 at 1200, unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described Areas is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibits A-C. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibits, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/main/r4/alert-notices>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

6. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same or similar acts in/on the same Described Area and Roads.
